### HIGH SCHOOL ENTRANCE/ PLACEMENT EXAMINATION

The Catholic high schools in the Diocese of Fall River will accept applications and administer an entrance/placement examination for new students on Saturday, December 1st with the make-up exam on Saturday, December 8th. Students wishing to enter any of these schools next September should report to the school of their choice by 7:45 am as testing begins at 8:00 am. High schools include:

Bishop Connolly High, Fall River Bishop Feehan High, Attleboro St. John Paul II High, Hyannis Bishop Stang High, No. Dartmouth Coyle and Cassidy High, Taunton

The application and examination procedure will last until approximately 11:30 a m. There will be a \$20.00 fee, payable at the time of application. The students need bring no records with them, nor do the parents have to accompany them. Information regarding courses, athletics and financial aid, etc. will be given at the time of the examination, or can be obtained by contacting the school at any time.

## INTERESTED IN BECOMING AN ALTAR SERVER?
