**INTERESTED IN BECOMING

They must be mature enough to understand their responsibilities and to carry them out with appropriate reverence. They must have received First Holy Communion and they must attend Mass on a regular basis. If you are interested in becoming an altar server and are, in the fall, **beginning fourth grade or higher**, please contact the parish office to indicate your interest. In those sessions we will review the duties one performs as an altar server and address any questions you may have about your responsibilities.
