INTERESTED IN BECOMING AN ALTAR SERVER?

They must be mature enough to understand their responsibilities and to carry them out with appropriate reverence. They must have received First Holy Communion and they must attend Mass on a regular basis. If you are interested in becoming an altar server and are, in the fall, **beginning fourth grade or higher**, please contact the parish office to indicate your interest. (508-823-9833) You will then be notified concerning **mandatory** attendance at two training sessions, to be held in the November-December time period. In those sessions we will review the duties one performs as an altar server and address any questions you may have about your responsibilities. A second opportunity to express interest in becoming an altar server will be offered in October, when a presentation and a sign-up sheet will be offered to the fourth grade formation classes.
